In the past, we have hosted school and community groups, organised the Children's program of the Perth Garden Festival, school holiday programs for the Perth Cultural Centre, and plenty more.

# FARM TOURS

We love to show people of all ages around Perth City Farm. Tours make for excellent excursions and are particularly popular with both primary and high schools, VET/TAFE courses and university groups, gardening clubs and social groups. Tours must be booked in advance, and we run them Tuesday – Thursday between 9am and 3pm.

You'll Learn about the history of Perth City Farm, what we're all about, and our current sustainability efforts as you tour the gardens.

## TAILORED TOURS

Tours can be tailored to emphasise certain aspects of the farm; re-wilding for native wildlife and pollinators, urban food growing, recycling and reusing, or worms and healthy soils.

Our minimum fee is based on a group of up to 10 participants, but we can accommodate groups of up to 80 with a blend of workshops and talks/demos focusing on particular topics. Larger groups require a half or full day visit.

## SINGLE GROUPS / CLASSES - up to 20 participants inc GST

Single 1hr tour for up to 10pax \$190

Single 1hr tour for up to 20pax \$260

2hr visit with a tour + an activity/demo up to 20pax \$540

## LARGER GROUPS / FULL CO-HORT

2hr visit with a tour + an activity/demo for up to 40pax \$950

3hr visit with a tour + 2x activities/demos for up to 60pax \$1800  
Each session is 50mins, allowing for 10min swaps + morning tea break

4hr visit with a tour + 3x activities/demos for up to 80pax \$2650  
Each session is 50mins, allowing for 10min swaps + morning tea break
